School Board to be replaced by a 'Parent Council'

At the School Board AGM on Tuesday 14th May Sandra Martin, Parent and Pupil Participation Officer, outlined the changes to the School Board legislation which take effect from August.

Under the new legislation, all parents will automatically become members of the Parent Forum from which each school will be expected to set up a Parent Council. The aim of the structure to replace School Boards is designed to encourage more parents to play a more active role in the life and work of the school.

In June, a working group will be set up to look at the options for a Parent Council in Bell Baxter. All parents will be consulted on these options.
